

## *Find Book Reviews*

---

### *General Book Review Sources*

#### *Expanded Academic ASAP (Gale)*

Covers 1980 – present.

Search for the book title or author name along with the word “review”.

#### *Global Books in Print*

On the results page, you can identify which titles are reviewed by a star near the title in **Search Results**. Click on the title and then on the “Title Reviews” tab.

#### *The New York Times*

Click on Books on left navigation bar. Register (free) to receive Book Review Podcasts.

#### *JSTOR*

**Covers from the beginning of the journal (earliest is 1665) up to within three to five years of the present [the "moving wall"].** Rich in book reviews and review journals for specific subjects and disciplines, JSTOR is a fully-searchable, full-text database containing the back issues of several hundred scholarly journals in the humanities, social sciences, mathematics, music, ecology and botany, business, and other fields.

To find book reviews, select **Advanced Search**. Type one or two keywords from the book title in the first search box. Under **Narrow Your Search** to “These Types,” check the **Review** box. Click Search.

#### *Project MUSE.*

Covers 1993 – present.

Project MUSE is a unique collaboration between libraries and publishers providing 100% full-text online access to over 300 high quality humanities, arts, and social sciences journals from 60 scholarly publishers.

To find book reviews, choose Advanced Search and use the pulldown menu under Limit Search and By Type to select Review.

### *ProQuest 5000*

In Advanced Search, type in author or title keywords and “book review” as the Document Type.

### *Web of Science*

Covers:

Science Citation Index 1945 – present

Social Science Citation Index 1956 – present

Arts and Humanities Citation Index 1975 – present

Under “General Search” search for book title words and limit to publication type “book review”.

## *Subject Specific Book Review Sources*

### *ABI/Inform*

Book reviews in economics and business.

### *Business Source Premier*

Covers 1922-present.

For articles about a book, enter author and title words. Limit results by selecting Book Reviews under Document Type.

### *EconLit*

Book reviews in economics. Search on author or book title keywords and limit to document type “book reviews”

### *Historical Abstracts*

Covers 1955 – present.

To search for book reviews, enter the author's name or title of the book under "Keywords," placing the title in quotation marks. Under "Subject Terms " enter "Book Reviews," and then click on "Search."

### *MathSciNet*

**Publications** searches the review database and returns bibliographic data, reviews and (when available) linked reference lists for article and book listings.

### *PsycINFO*

Covers 1872 – present.

To search for book reviews, select the "Advanced Search" option. In the first search box, enter the author or the title of the book being reviewed, placing the title in quotation marks. Then choose "Review" from the "Document Type" drop-down menu below. Click on "Search."

Reviews general interest books monthly, focusing on new releases. It typically reviews up to 100 of each month's new fiction, nonfiction, business, children's, spoken-word audio, and how-to books. The searchable archives include issues back to 1996.

#### ***BookReview.com***

Reviews books that may be overlooked due to odd subjects or unknown authors. The reviews draw from a variety of publishers and cover a multitude of subjects and genres. A searchable archive is included.
