#### *New books in the library*

#### **Table Of Contents Alert**

Select publications for which you wish to receive notifications of new issues.

#### **Keyword Alert**

With Springer Keyword alerts, users can register a keyword and each time the keyword appears in a publication on SpringerLink, the user will receive an e-mail notification.

## KEEPING CURRENT WITH NEW JOURNAL ARTICLES

### *American Chemical Society Publications*

Click on **Email Alerts & RSS Feeds** at top.

### *Australian Bureau of Statistics*

From the ABS home page, <http://www.abs.gov.au>, click on the **Free E-mail Notification Service**.

### *Cambridge Scientific Abstracts Databases*

To set up a new alert, first run the search in your selected databases. Click the **Alerts** button.

### *Current Contents Connect (ISI)*

You can set up an alert for tables of contents of journals as well as for saved searches.

- Enter your search terms and perform search. When you are satisfied with your results, click "Save History." You will be taken to the Save Search History page. You **must** save it to ISI's server not the local workstation.
- Sign in with your email address and a password in order to create the Current Contents Connect alert. If this is your first time using ISI Web of Knowledge click on the "Register" link and follow the instructions there.
- Once you have signed in, enter a History Name and, if desired, a description.
- Check off the box next to "Send me Email Alerts." Your email address will be filled in automatically. If you wish to change the address to which the alert email will be sent, do so now.
- Select Alert type and Email Format.
- Click "Save" to save your history to the server. You will be returned to the Current Contents Connect database.

#### **How do I create a simple table of contents alert?**

- Select My Journal List from the drop-down list box at the top of any Current Contents Connect search page.
- Sign in with your email address and a password in order to create the Current Contents Connect alert. If this is your first time using ISI Web of Knowledge click on the "Register" link and follow the instructions there.

- Select your titles from either the alphabetical or subject lists and mark them for an auto alert. You may also type in the title of interest.
- Using this method will send you an individual email for each journal title as it is updated. If you would like to include several titles in one email, follow the steps described previously to create a search, using the search fields box to specify journal title and type your journal title names in the search box. If a journal title includes a Boolean operator, the journal title must be entered in quotes, e.g. “Food and Drug Law Journal” Then follow the steps to create an alert.

Click on **My Profile** at left.

***ScienceDirect***

You need to register to create a personal profile first before you can set up alerts. Registration is free.

Click on **Alerts**.

Under **My Alerts**, you have three options:

- Search Alert (notifies you by email when new articles matching your search are added to ScienceDirect)
- Journal Issue Alert (notifies you by email when new issues of selected journals are added to ScienceDirect)
- Citation Alert (notifies you by email when new articles that cite a specific article of interest are added to ScienceDirect)

#### Search Alert

Define and run a search  
Save the search as **Save as Search Alert**.

#### Journal Issue Alert

Click on My Alerts  
Select the Journals  
Add/Remove the Journals

#### Citation Alert

While viewing the article of interest, click the **Save as Citation Alert** link.

#### *Standards Online Premium Australia*

Click on **StandardsWatch** and click on “I want to set up a free account”.

#### *Wiley Interscience*

Click on the **Register Now** to register.
